College Level Courses

East Carter High School's SBDM Council shall offer a core curriculum of Advanced Placement, Dual Enrollment, or Dual Credit courses, using either on-site (face-to-face classroom) and/or on-line instruction.

Dual Credit classes are advertised to the senior class and are offered to any senior who has scored benchmark on their ACT Test (Reading – 20; English-18; and Math-21). Notification is given to students the preceding semester and any student who wishes to take dual credit classes.

AP classes are also offered to sophomores, juniors, and seniors through open enrollment.

In addition, SBDM Council shall comply with any additional requirements for advance placement and dual credit courses that may be established cooperatively by the Kentucky Department of Education, the Educational Professional Standards Board and the Council on Postsecondary Education in accordance with the definitions in Section 1 of the following Acts: KRS160.348 (1) and KRS160.348(2).
