ENHANCING ACHIEVEMENT – LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

East Carter High School SBDM Council promotes shared leadership between those who are closest to students. Our school administrative team consists of the principal, assistant principal, central office personnel, school counselors and LMS. The school leadership team meets once per month and consists of department heads. Department heads take the leadership team discussions back to their department to discuss and bring feedback to the team. This allows for entire faculty involvement in the discussions phase with ideas and recommendations frequently added as agenda items for SBDM that help enhance student achievement. Council members include parents, teachers, and administrators of the local school. The SBDM Council then has the responsibility through KRS160.345 2(c)(1) to set school policy consistent with Carter County Board of Education Policy, which shall provide a learning environment to enhance the students' achievement and help the school meet the goals established by KRS 160.345(2)(c)1 and KRS158.6451.
