ALIGNMENT WITH STATE STANDARDS

The school shall organize all instructional and other activities to be aligned with state standards established in state laws and regulations, and in a manner that is consistent with local school board policy. Programs shall be appraised upon request of the school council by assigning the program appraisal to the appropriate committee for completion and recommendation to the council. The school council policy shall be consistent with the applicable indicators from the Standards and Indicators for School Improvement.
